

# Architecture Transfer Pathway: CRC

1. Architecture course transfers are based on [portfolio review](#) and transcript evaluation.
2. A maximum of 75 units can be transferred to the [B.Arch program](#) (or 60 units to the BA program).
3. Courses must be at least 3 units and passed with a grade of C or higher.
4. General Education course transfers are finalized by the registrar and not the School of Architecture.
