

# Landscape Architecture Transfer Pathway: CRC

1. Landscape Architecture course transfers are based on portfolio review and transcript evaluation.
2. A maximum of 60 units can be transferred to the BFA Landscape Architecture program.
3. Courses must be at least 3 units and passed with a grade of C or higher.
4. General Education course transfers are finalized by the registrar and not the School of Landscape Architecture.
